### Dear Ministry Partner,

Our joint investments and prayers as a family are reaping lasting fruit. Through the Festival of Hope in Wum which involved training, free medical consultation and drugs, a prayer breakfast with dignitaries, a visit to the Paramount Fon of the Aghem clan, ministers' conferences, crusades and follow up sessions - over 1.000 lives have been transformed by the preaching of the gospel of Jesus in word and deed! We are grateful for the opportunity to share some victories with you as we praise God together for His faithfulness.







### Medical Outreach

Many interesting comments were made with regard to this Outreach. One lady was overheard saying to her friend: "Their nurses are so polite, respectful and concerned, contrary to the insults and arrogance we know in our hospitals." "They are indeed fast. I was number 149, and they reached my number before 11:00 am. Were it in our hospital, 4:00 pm would have met me here." The friend said: "See, I went to our hospital and they prescribed me drugs for 11,000 francs. That was last week. Where would I have had that kind of money? But see what Jesus has done for me today; I have gotten everything free of charge."

It is worth noting that about a third of the total number of patients consulted during the medical outreach were Muslims. When one Bororo (Northern Cameroon/Fulani/Muslim) man was asked whether the team could pray for him in Jesus' name, he replied that if truly it was Jesus who was giving him the drugs, why not. By the end of the outreach, 421 out of the 935 patients counselled made the commitment for Christ for the very first time (see details in statistics below.)



## Prayer Breakfast

This event – which has been described as an unprecedented Door Opening to the Church in Wum and an Eye Opener to the authorities there - saw the participation of 35 leaders. Among those present were the Member of Parliament for Menchum Division, the Commissioner for Public Security, and some members of the Legal Department. The testimonies are overwhelming, as we have observed a remarkable transformation in the lives of some of the dignitaries who attended the event.
